**Guidelines for Placement on the Salary Schedule**

1. Teachers will be given up to fifteen years teaching experience for successful teaching in an accredited public or private elementary and/or secondary school system.
2. Horizontal placement will be determined by graduate hours and degrees above the Bachelor's degree. All graduate hours and degrees must be approved prior to advancement on the salary schedule.
3. Master's programs that require 45 or more graduate hours will be placed at the MS+16 column. An additional 16 graduate hours will move the individual to the MS +32 column.
4. Step level does not indicate years of experience.

This salary schedule includes the equivalent of one day of compensation for additional collaborative team meetings to occur during the calendar year adopted by the Board of Education and as scheduled by building and District administrators.
